**Drayton Hall** - Held in the Drayton family for seven generations, Drayton Hall (c. 1738) is the oldest and finest surviving examples of Georgian Palladian architecture in the South. Noted for its rich handcrafted detail, Drayton Hall is in amazingly pristine condition.
