

## **Visiting Kiawah Island by air just became much more affordable.**

AirTran Airways announced it would begin service to Charleston International Airport (CHS) on May 24. Initially, it will provide non-stop daily service between Charleston and Atlanta Hartsfield International, with two more flights beginning June 7. Introductory fares begin at \$59 one-way.
