



## Traveling information to Kiawah Island

Kiawah Island is located 21 miles south of Charleston, South Carolina and within driving distance from many other major cities.

### Directions to Kiawah

**Driving from the North or West:** Approach the Charleston area on I-95 South and/or I-26 East to I-526 West. Follow I-526 to 17 South, travel about 5 miles and turn left onto Main Road. Follow the signs to Kiawah Island.

**Driving from the South:** Follow I-95 North to US-17 North (Charleston - Exit 33). Travel 52 miles on US-17, then turn right onto Main Road. Follow the signs to Kiawah Island.

#### **Arriving by private watercraft:**

Kiawah Island is accessible by water via the Atlantic Ocean, the Intracoastal Waterway and the Kiawah River. For details please contact our concierge.

### ***Driving Directions to Downtown Charleston from Kiawah***

Take the Kiawah Island Parkway past the security gate to Bohicket Road. Turn right and remain on Bohicket Road for 10 miles. At the first traffic light (McDonald's on right) make a right turn onto Maybank Highway (Rt. 700). Follow Maybank Highway for 7 miles until you reach Folly Road (Rt. 171), make a right, and then make an immediate left onto Harborview Road. Proceed under the overpass, the turn left onto Route 30 toward Charleston. This road will take you into downtown Charleston in 3 minutes.
