



Frequently Asked Questions

My kids are going to be in different age groups, is there a way they can stay together? Kamp Kiawah strictly follows the counselor to camper ratio that is listed below. If the older child would like to join the younger child's group, they are more than welcome. However, the younger child will not be allowed to move up an age group.

- 3&4 year olds 5:1
- 5-7 year olds 8:1
- 8-11 year olds 12:1

My child has food allergies, are they still allowed to attend kamp? Yes! Kamp Kiawah respects and honors all food allergies. We also administer an additional allergy wristband upon check-in to make sure all of our staff is well informed of the allergy. If you would like to pack a camper's snack or lunch, please do so; just remember Kamp Kiawah is a nut free facility!

How are the campers supervised during their swim time? All campers are closely supervised during swim time. When campers go to the pool there are at least 2 counselors with them, if not more. One of these counselors is in the pool with the children engaging them in games and activities, while the other counselor acts as a lifeguard on the pool deck. Campers that are 5-11 year olds are only allowed in the 3-4.5ft deep area and must pass a swim test before they are allowed into the water. All 3 & 4 year olds go swimming in the wading pool which is 1.5 ft deep.

I forgot a towel & sunscreen for my child, should I run back and get one? No. The pool shop has extra towels for use, and Counselors always spray campers with sunscreen before they go to the pool with our own sunscreen.

I have a 3 year old whose older siblings are attending kamp. The 3 year old is almost potty trained, can they attend? No, campers must be 100% potty trained to attend kamp, we do not accept children in diapers, pull-ups or training pants. Please do not pack these items in their bags either.

My child was only signed up for the morning session however, now they would like to stay for the full day session, what options are available? Your child is more than welcome to stay with us! The additional charge will be added to your bill when you pick-up your camper up at 4pm.

I am going to be 30 minutes late picking up my child, is this ok? Yes, just call the Nature Center Counselors can plan accordingly. You also will be charged an extra \$3/child/5 minutes you are running late.

Can my Nanny stay with my children during kamp? No. Kamp Kiawah is a place for children to make friendships, learn and create memories with other children their own age. However, nannies are allowed to pick-up and drop off children if parents request.
